



The Stone Soup Leadership Institute Young Heroes Award to Benita Davis

MASSACHUSETTS -- August 1, 2021: The Stone Soup Leadership Institute is pleased to present its third **Young Heroes Award** to 26 year old Benita Davis in Guyana for her leadership with the River Guardian Project. Other recipients include 16 year old Autumn Peltier, Water Walker of the Anishinabek Nation in Canada and 24 year old Vanessa Nakate, founder of Rise Up Africa! for her Green Schools Solar Panel Project in Uganda. These youth leaders are among the 100 young heroes in the book, *Stone Soup for a Sustainable World: Life-Changing Stories of Young Heroes*.

A trip to Guyana's interior opened her eyes to the myriad ways mining and oil exploration is hurting the country's natural resources, such as its rivers, lakes and streams, and impacting indigenous communities. The time she spent in the Kaieteur National Park – living off the land and the river alongside indigenous communities – inspired her to educate her compatriots about the importance of protecting freshwater resources. Guyana is called the "land of many waters," and as a water guardian, Benita is on the front lines of the battle to protect this precious resource.

The Land of Many Waters

The **Young Heroes Award** supports young leaders who are on the front lines of climate change - social, economic, environmental justice who are featured in the book, *Stone Soup for a Sustainable World: Life-Changing Stories of Young Heroes*.
